# NAURU CORONAVIRUS TASKFORCE

## HAVE YOU RECENTLY HAD COVID-19 / TESTED POSITIVE TO COVID-19 AND PLAN TO TRAVEL TO NAURU?

If you are currently infected with COVID-19 or test positive on a COVID test (PCR or RAT), you cannot travel to Nauru until you recover.

Details are provided below in STEP 2 for what you need to do before you can travel to Nauru, after you have fully recovered from COVID-19 and can no longer spread the virus.

#### STEP 1.

You must comply with any applicable Australian or Queensland Government regulations and requirements for persons who test positive.

You must first comply with any applicable Australian or Queensland Government regulations and requirements for persons who test positive or are a Close Contact.

In Queensland, as at July 2022;

- <u>If you test positive</u> for COVID-19 you must **immediately isolate** for at least 7 days.
- If you tested positive using a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) at home, you must **report your result** to Queensland Health.
- You must **tell your household contacts** to follow the steps for a Close Contact.

You are responsible for obtaining up to date information from official Australian and Queensland Government sources to ensure you do what is required. Official websites have up to date information.

# STEP 2.

If you need to travel to Nauru after recently being infected / testing positive to COVID-19,

you will need to wait a prescribed period and then be medically cleared, before your travel to Nauru

## **RECENTLY TEST POSITIVE TO COVID-19?**

- Provide evidence of your COVID infection; obtain a copy of the formal Laboratory test result, Certificate of Observed RAT test (Doctor, Pharmacist, Lab) or Certificate of Registration of a personal RAT test from the relevant Government Authority
- Wait a minimum of 13 days following your positive test result
- You must have had a minimum of 3 days without any COVID symptoms.

If you are still symptomatic after day 10, you must wait longer and until you have fully recovered, with no symptoms for at least 3 days before seeing your doctor.

• See your Doctor and ask them to complete the form 'Certificate of Recovery from COVID-19

Submit the documents to Nauru Airlines or the Nauru COVID-19 Taskforce, at least 24 hours before your travel.

Note:

If you tested positive to COVID-19 **more than 3 months** ago, then these procedures do not apply to you, and you will need to provide a negative COVID-19 PCR test result within 72hrs of your travel.
